

Night Diving Procedures

In addition to <u>normal low risk dive procedurethe</u> following procedures shall be followed for night diving:

- 1. The dive site should be marked prior to the night dive;
- 2. The site entry and exit points shall be marked with an activated light source;
- 3. Divers must be experienced in night diving unless participating in a sanctioned training exercise;
- 4. All divers shall have an activated cyalumes (or other suitable light source) attached in a prominent position to their equipment;
- 5. Divers must carry a working underwater torch and a backup light/torch;
- 6. A minimum of two surface personnel must be present.
- 7. Boats need to call OIRS staff on the radio reporting way in and way out.
