Materials: books, audio-visual items, periodicals

Unsolicited donations: Donations of unsolicited library materials presented or sent to the Library.

- x Individual issues/volumes which fill gaps in the print collection or fill gaps in the North Queensland collections.
- x Individual title runs of five years or more where a new subscription will be placed, or the title is significant for the collection.
- x Backset holdings which extend or complete the runs of print holdings and which are significant for the collection
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3 Approval of Formed Collection Donations

3.1 Formal acceptance of formed collections is normally by the Director, Library and Information Services based on the recommendation of the Associate Director, Information Resources.
